

## PATIENT CHECKLIST FOR SURGERY

The Surgery Center will call you **1 - 2 days prior to surgery** to notify you of your arrival time for the procedure.

You will have a **same-day post-op** visit to check your comfort and review your aftercare instructions. After you leave the surgery center, come directly to the Champion Eyecare for this visit. Please leave your eye shield in place.

2. A Pre-Op clearance from your PCP is required - within 30 days of your surgery date.

Please schedule this appointment as soon as possible. You may be required to have a Cardiac Clearance, depending on your health history. Labs and an EKG also might be performed if required by your PCP (EKGs within the past 6 months are accepted).

\*\* PLEASE BRING THE PROVIDED H&P FORM TO YOUR APPOINTMENT SO YOUR PCP MAY COMPLETE AND FAX IT TO OUR OFFICE. \*\*

All clearances must be received by our office at least 3 business days prior to surgery. Clearances not received by the deadline are subject to cancellation.

3. There are costs and fees associated with surgery, which typically come from medical insurance.

(Deductibles, Co-Payments, Co-Insurance, etc.) Our Surgical Coordinator will review your insurance prior to surgery and give you an estimate of any Physician fees.

The Surgery Center will contact you regarding Facility fees, Anesthesia fees, or other related costs.

\*\*Remember, these are <u>estimates</u> obtained prior to surgery, so you may or may not have a further remaining balance after surgery once your insurance processes your claim.

ALL UPGRADE COSTS AND BALANCES (including REFRACTION) MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO SURGERY.

	A nurse from the surgery center will contact you prior to surgery with your Pre-Op instructions and answer any questions you may have.  ****DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING PAST MIDNIGHT. You may take certain medications with a small sip of water the morning of surgery, but nothing else.					
5.	Bring a responsible driver with you the day of surgery. <u>PLEASE ANTICIPATE THAT YOUR DRIVER MUST REMAIN AT THE SURGERY CENTER DURING YOUR PROCEDURE</u> . If you are unable to make it to surgery due to unforeseen circumstances, i.e. illness, please contact our office and the surgery center IMMEDIATELY to avoid a cancellation fee.					
6.	You will need eye drops to be used before and after your procedure. Please begin pre-treating the operative eye with your drops <b>3 days prior</b> to surgery.
